

Bexar County Job Report June 2011

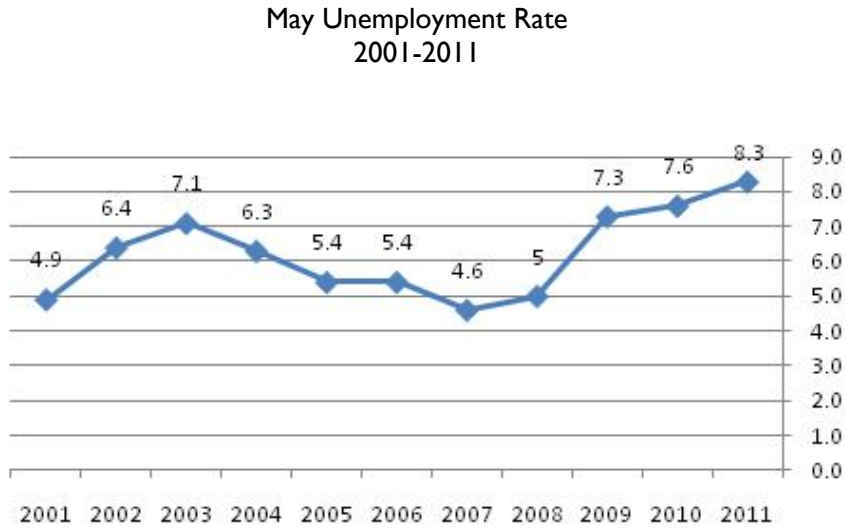
Workforce Solutions Alamo released information today indicating that the Bexar County unemployment rate increased to 8.3 percent in June, up from 7.5 percent reported in May.

Bexar County’s unemployment rate was slightly higher than the overall jobless rate of 8.1 percent for the 12-county Workforce Solutions Alamo area, which includes Atascosa, Bandera, Comal, Frio, Gillespie, Guadalupe, Karnes, Kendall, Kerr, Medina and Wilson counties. Gillespie County registered the lowest unemployment rate in June amongst the counties at 5.5% and Karnes County registered the highest rate at 10.0%.

Comparing the Workforce Solutions Alamo metro area to the state and nation, the Texas unadjusted (actual) unemployment rate increased to 8.8 percent in June, up from 7.9 percent in May. The nation’s unadjusted (actual) unemployment rate also increased to 9.3 percent in June up from 8.7 reported in May. Comparatively, the state and nation release seasonally adjusted unemployment rates with Texas increasing to 8.2 percent in June up from 8.0 percent in May, and the nation’s unemployment rate increasing to 9.2 percent, up from 9.1 percent reported in June.

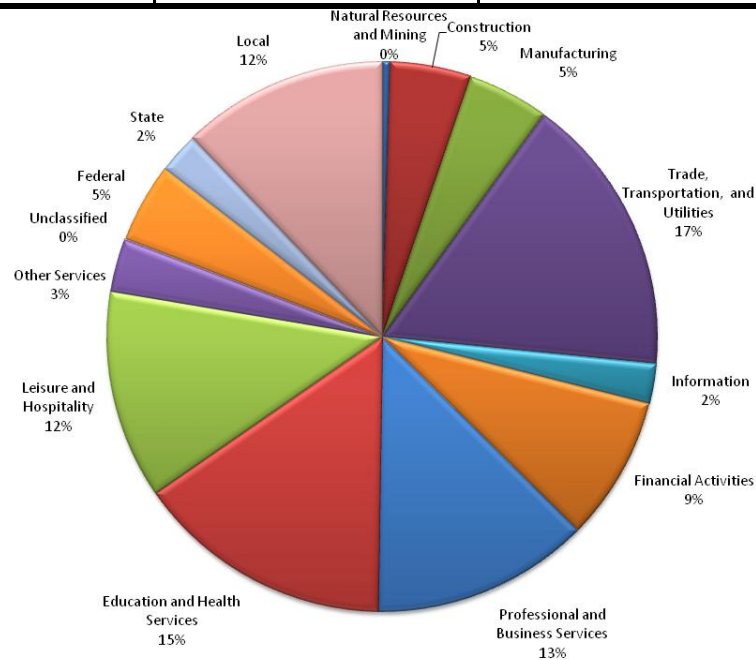
