

Wilson County Job Report July 2011

Workforce Solutions Alamo released information indicating that the Wilson County unemployment rate for the month of July was 8.2 percent, same as reported in June.

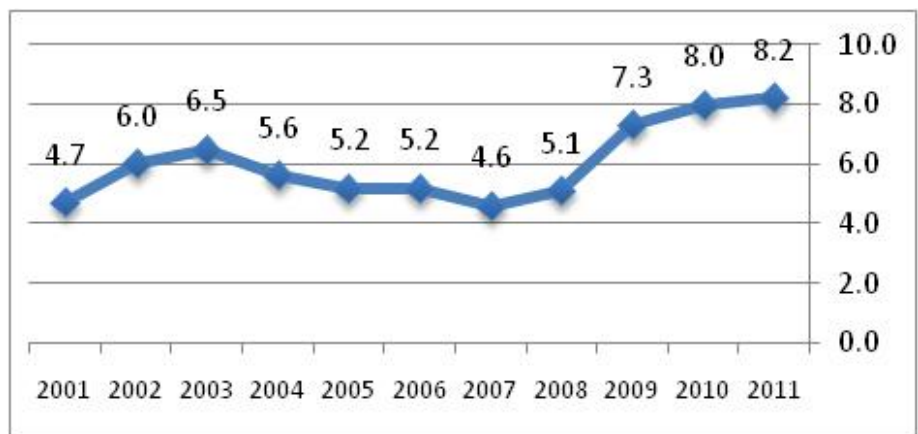
Wilson County’s unemployment rate was slightly higher than the overall jobless rate of 8.1 percent for the 12-county Workforce Solutions Alamo area, which includes Atascosa, Bandera, Comal, Frio, Gillespie, Guadalupe, Karnes, Kendall, Kerr, Medina and Wilson counties. Gillespie County registered the lowest unemployment rate in July amongst the counties at 5.5% and Karnes County registered the highest rate at 9.9%.

When the Workforce Solutions Alamo metro area is compared to the State and Nation, the Texas unadjusted (actual) unemployment rate decreased slightly to 8.7 percent in July, down from 8.8 percent in June. The nation’s unadjusted (actual) unemployment rate stayed at 9.3 percent in July, up the same rate reported in June. Comparatively, the state and nation seasonally adjusted unemployment rates with Texas increasing to 8.4 percent in July, up from 8.2 percent in June; and, the nation holding steady at 9.3 percent in July, the same rate reported in June.

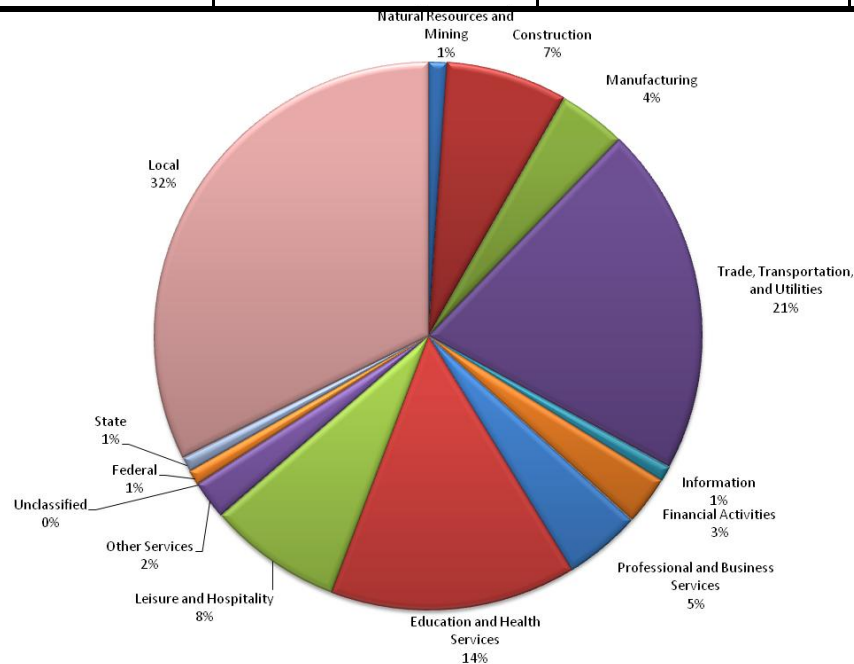
