This announcement comes under the advisement of the Texas Workforce Commission and follows the closures of other workforce centers throughout the state in an effort to mitigate the spread of COVID-19. We understand that the need for our services remains critical, and we are committed to providing services to all employers and residents needing assistance during these trying times. Though the Career Centers will be closed to the public, our team will continue to work diligently to serve those in need. Our phone systems and online applications remain open. We are also exploring ways to bolster our online services and collaborate with our partners to help inform the public about where to find help. WSA will continue to offer individuals a comprehensive suite of employment, training, educational and supportive services, including soft skills training programs and resources as well as child care services. Our goal remains to remove as many barriers as possible for our clients to gain meaningful employment. We are asking the public's cooperation as we continue to adjust to the growing demand for our services. We want to assure those needing our assistance that there are sufficient resources to assist all those who need our services.
