

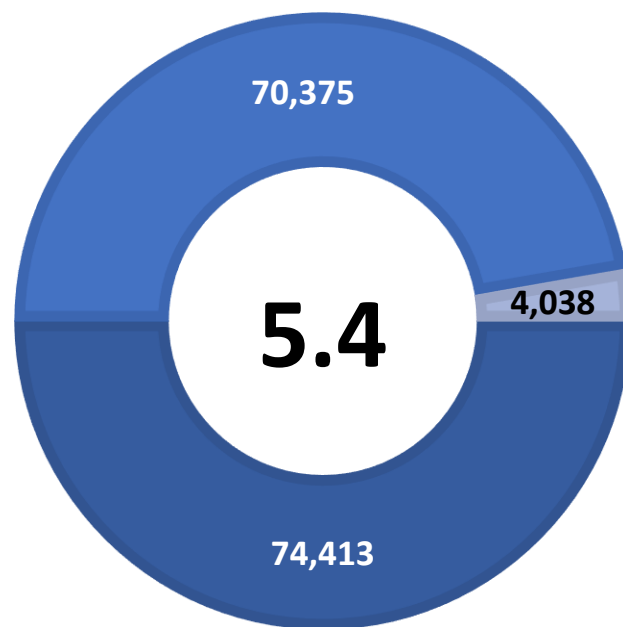
COMAL COUNTY UNEMPLOYMENT RATE DECREASES TO 5.4 PERCENT

Note: Only the actual/unadjusted series unemployment rate estimates for Texas and the US are comparable to sub-state unemployment rates. Adjusted rates are calculated by smoothing out the changes in unemployment due to the typical seasonal hiring and layoffs. Rates reported are estimates and variations in previously reported rates can occur with BLS readjustments.

Highlights

- **5.4% August County Unemployment Rate (Not Seasonally Adjusted)**
- **4,038 people actively looking and available for work**
- **DOWN** from 6.7% in July after BLS adjustment
- **LOWER** than the 6.5% Unemployment Rate 13-County WDA Area
- **LOWER** than the 7.0% Unemployment Rate for the State of Texas
- **COMAL Unemployment Rate ranked 5th highest in the 13-County WDA Area**
