The event will take place on Monday, November 18th at Education Service Center, Region 20. The purpose of this event is to bring awareness to juniors and seniors in high school on different career pathways in four in-demand industries in the greater San Antonio area: Healthcare, Advanced Manufacturing, Construction, and Information Technology.

During the summit, students will rotate through a series of learning activities to include four different workshops and two keynote sessions. In the workshops, students will learn about internships and apprenticeship programs as well as college degrees, technical school programs, industry certifications, and resources available in their community. In addition, career success and leadership coaches will engage students in discussions where they will tap into their passion and discover their power to overcome limiting beliefs, connect with who they are at their core, and visualize their future.

Students attending the summit are currently enrolled in Career & Technical Education programs in San Antonio ISD, Southside ISD, Southwest ISD, Randolph-Field ISD, Harlandale ISD, Brooks Academy, School of Science & Technology, School of Excellence, CAST Tech High School, and San Antonio Youth Alternative School.

Career Pathways is a tri-agency effort where the Texas Education Agency (TEA), the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board (THECB), and the Texas Workforce Commission (TWC) work closely together to boost college and career readiness in the development of high-quality college and career frameworks. By better preparing youth for an evolving economy, they will be ready to fill in-demand job opportunities in high wage fields.
