


CITY OF SAN ANTONIO UNEMPLOYMENT RATE INCREASES TO 8.0 PERCENT

Note: Only the actual/unadjusted series unemployment rate estimates for Texas and the US are comparable to substate unemployment rates. Adjusted rates are calculated by smoothing out the changes in unemployment due to the typical seasonal hiring and layoffs. Rates reported are estimates and variations in previously reported rates can occur with BLS readjustments.

Highlights

- 8.0% September City Unemployment Rate (Not Seasonally Adjusted)
- 59,230 people actively looking and available for work
- Up from 6.9% in August after BLS adjustment
- HIGHER than the 7.8% Unemployment Rate for the San Antonio-New Braunfels Metro Area
- LOWER than the 8.3% Unemployment Rate for the State of Texas
- City of San Antonio Unemployment Rate ranked 2nd highest in the San Antonio-New Braunfels Metro Area
