

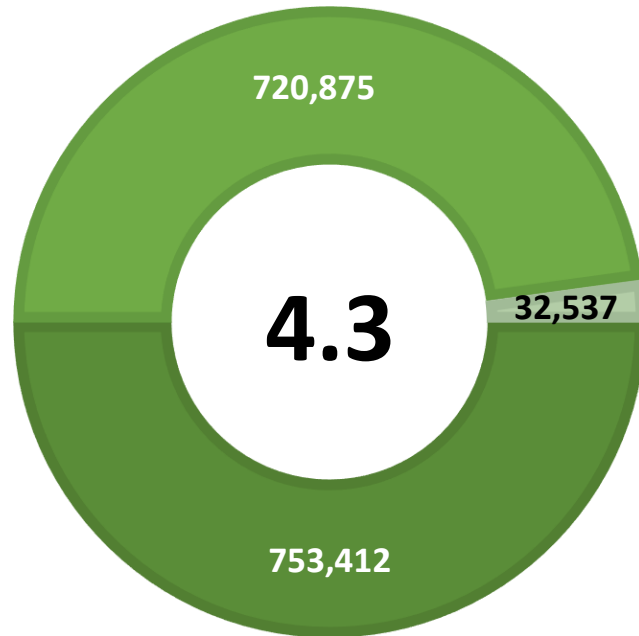

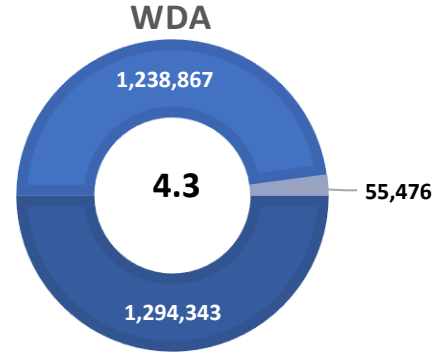

Highlights

- **4.3% October City Unemployment Rate (Not Seasonally Adjusted)**
- **32,537 people actively looking and available for work**
- **DOWN** from 4.5% in September
- **EQUAL** to the 4.3% Unemployment Rate for the San Antonio-New Braunfels Metro Area
- **LOWER** than the 4.8% Unemployment Rate for the State of Texas
- **City of San Antonio Unemployment Rate ranked 2nd highest in the San Antonio-New Braunfels Metro Area**

Note: Only the actual/unadjusted series unemployment rate estimates for Texas and the US are comparable to sub-state unemployment rates. Adjusted rates are calculated by smoothing out the changes in unemployment due to the typical seasonal hiring and layoffs. Rates reported are estimates and variations in previously reported rates can occur with BLS readjustments.

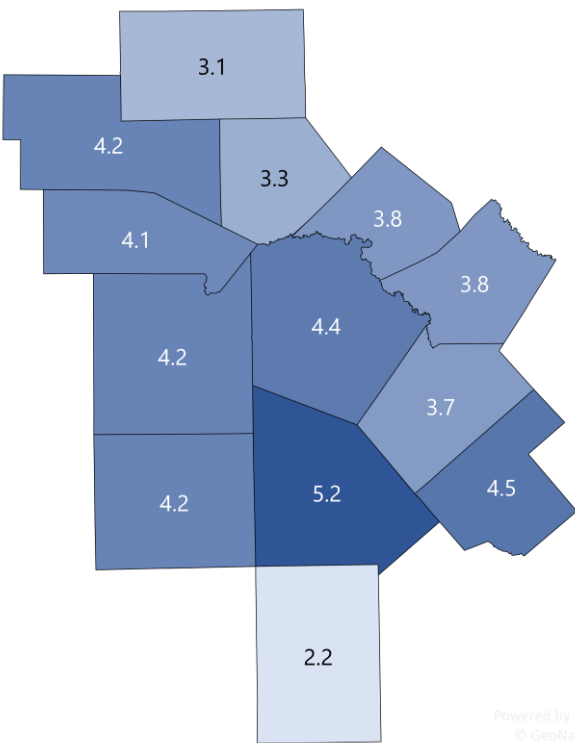
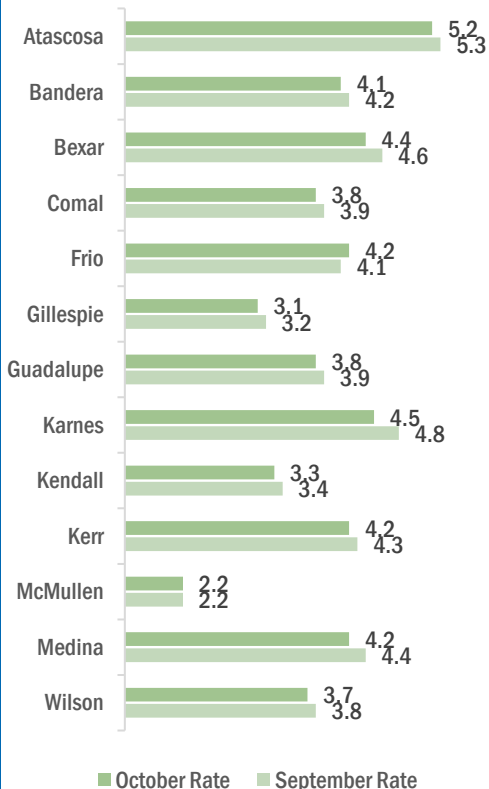
