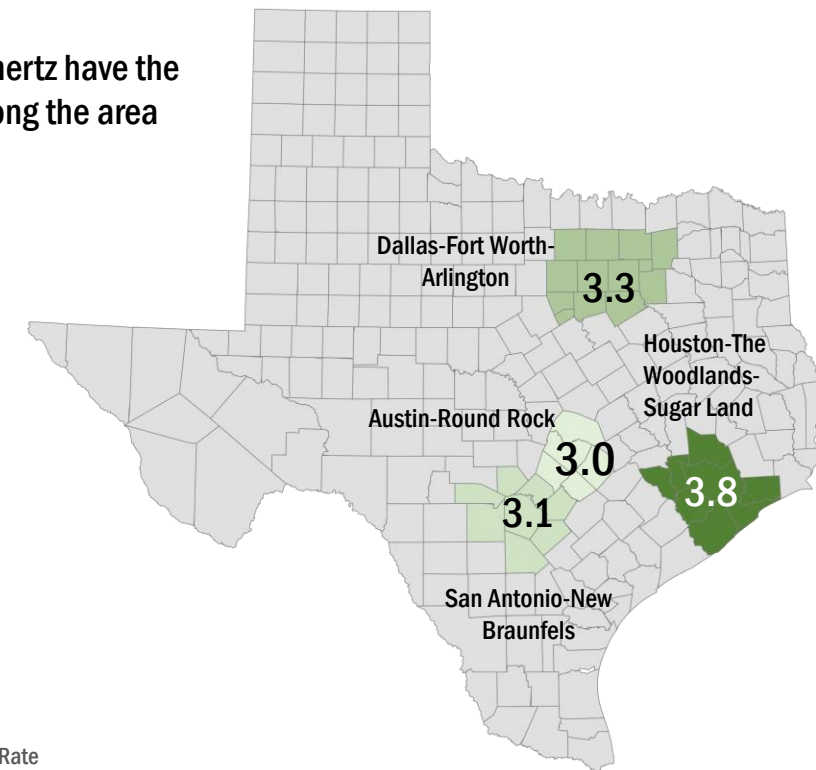
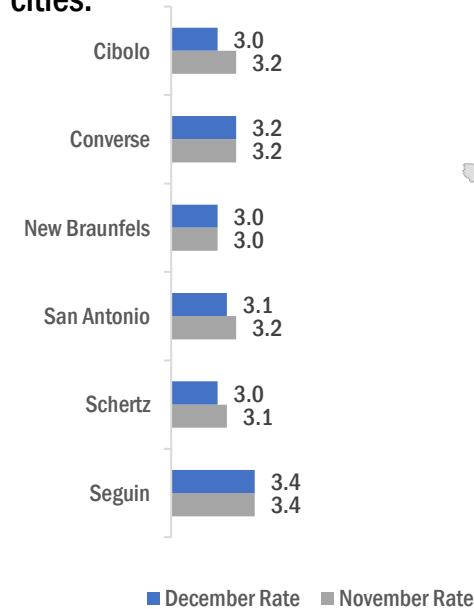

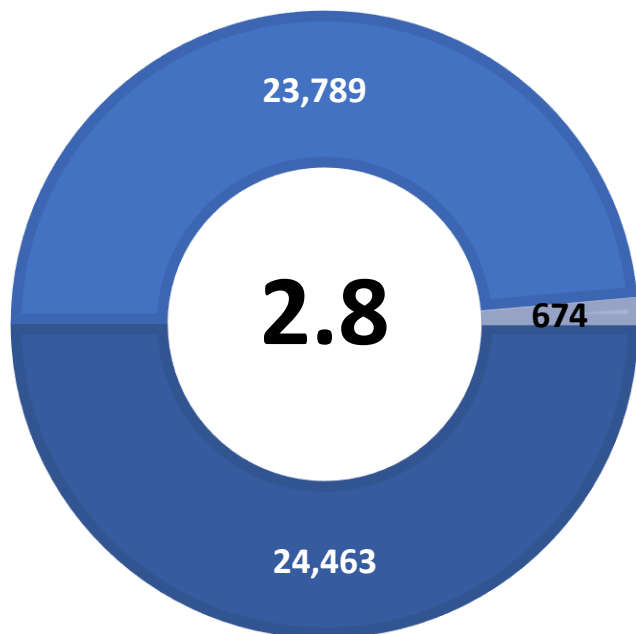
KENDALL COUNTY UNEMPLOYMENT RATE DECREASES TO 2.8 PERCENT

Highlights

- **2.8% December County Unemployment Rate (Not Seasonally Adjusted)**
- **674 people actively looking and available for work**
- **DOWN from 2.9% in November**
- **LOWER than the 3.1% Unemployment Rate for the 13-County WDA Area**
- **LOWER than the 3.5% Unemployment Rate for the State of Texas**
- **KENDALL Unemployment Rate ranked 5th lowest in the 13-County WDA Area**

Note: Only the actual/unadjusted series unemployment rate estimates for Texas and the US are comparable to sub-state unemployment rates. Adjusted rates are calculated by smoothing out the changes in unemployment due to the typical seasonal hiring and layoffs. Rates reported are estimates and variations in previously reported rates can occur with BLS readjustments.
